The Victorian School Building Authority is committed to assisting Peninsula Specialist College with recent storm damage to ensure the affected areas are made safe and returned to normal operations.

MAKE SAFE WORKS

The Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA) has been working closely with Peninsula Specialist College since Friday 10 May to address significant storm damage throughout the school.

The VSBA contractors attended site and worked over the weekend to address the storm damage in several areas of the school; these works included removing all non-salvageable items, drying carpet, repairing roof leaks, and ensuring all electrical equipment was not water-impacted.

Portable buildings at the school were made operational from Tuesday 14 May, with further works being coordinated in the damaged classrooms to ensure accessible learning spaces are available as soon as possible.

Next Steps

In bringing the areas of concern back to normal operations, the VSBA must engage various trades and specialists to undertake works. At this stage, we anticipate that the process will take up to two weeks, with potential investigative works to follow.

Further communications will be issued to the community as the project progresses.

The VSBA will continue to work closely with Peninsula Specialist College to ensure that the affected areas are returned to operational capacity, safely and within the scheduled timeline.
